

Bio – Sabine Mokry

Sabine Mokry is a PhD candidate at Leiden University's Political Science Department and a visiting researcher at the German Institute of Global and Area Studies (GIGA) in Hamburg. In her dissertation, she investigates under what conditions Chinese social actors, specifically think tankers, scholars and lobbyists, influence the construction of China's national interest. Before pursuing her PhD full-time, she worked at the Mercator Institute for China Studies (MERICS) as a research associate focusing on China's foreign and security policy. Based in Berlin, MERICS is Europe's largest think tank working on contemporary China. She obtained two master's degrees from Free University Berlin, one in International Relations and one in China Studies. Her work has appeared in the *Journal of Contemporary China* and has been published with Palgrave.
